

Our Objective

The Welfare Programme aims to assist clients in meeting their basic needs and to offer support to become socially integrated into South African communities.

Through a process of consultation, the team is able to assist individuals to access basic services such as medical care, schooling, shelter, SASSA grants and assistance with advice/application for voluntary repatriation. Services include home visits to the homes of our most vulnerable clients. The desk also manages a limited assistance programme which offers direct support to emergency and special cases.

Welfare clients must demonstrate a willingness to work alongside the Welfare team, by supporting change in their own life circumstances.

The Welfare Desk consults with clients Monday to Friday from 9:00 to 12:00, and in the afternoon by appointment.
